

# Widow's Pension Claim

## UNDER THE ACT OF 1917

On this 12 day of Feb, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighteen, personally appeared before me, a Notary Public in and for the County and State aforesaid. Ebbie Rymer

a resident of Benton County of Columbia

State of Florida, who being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain a pension under the provisions of Chapter 7259, Laws of Florida, approved June 7, 1917.

That she is the lawful widow of Jasper Rymer who enlisted under the name of Jasper Rymer on the day of 186, in Company

Regiment of the State of Florida

and who was honorably discharged at Daytona Beach, 186,

on account of Wounded in battle.

That he also served in the U.S. Cavalry.

That she was lawfully married to the said Jasper Rymer under the name of Ebbie Stobleton in the County of Noamilton State of Florida on the 28 day of February 1906, 18, and that she was not

divorced from him before nor has she remarried since his death, which occurred on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1915, in the County of Columbia, State of Florida

except as hereinafter stated.

That she is a resident of Columbia County, Florida, and has continuously resided in the State of Florida since the date of May Birth
