

# SOLDIER'S PENSION CLAIM

UNDER THE ACT OF 1909.

(FORM A.)

County of Nassau

On this August day of August, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace in and for the county and State aforesaid, Mr. Malachi Thompson who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 77 years of age, having been born on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1832 in the county of Bryan and and, in the State of Georgia. That he is a bona fide citizen of the county of Nassau, State of Florida. That he has resided in the State of Florida continuously since the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, 1865.

That he is the identical person who enlisted at Court House Bryan County Ga under the name of Malachi Thompson, on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, 1867, in Company E, Bryan guard, Regiment 4<sup>th</sup> of the State of Georgia in the service of the Confederate States Army, C. S. A.

and who was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Court House on sick furlough in the State of Georgia, on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 1864, on account of Said sick furlough with fever & chronic diarrhea.

on disability - 3 no other service I was  
unable to return to my command

None & sick with above stated Malady till  
close of the war

That I served faithfully until HONORABLY DISCHARGED from the service of the Confederate States Army in the year 1864, and did not desert the service of the said Confederate cause nor take the oath of allegiance to the United States until after the surrender of the Confederate Armies.

That I was at Home in Bryan county Georgia
