

Soldier's Application for Pension.

On this 13 day of September, 1899, personally appeared before me, Clerk of the Circuit Court in and for said county and State, Malachi Thompson

who being by me duly sworn, declares he is the identical person who enlisted on or about the day of September 1861, in Captain W. P. Phillips, Company, county of Effingham, in the State of Georgia, and that while in actual service in said company, Co. 47th Regiment, of the State of Georgia, and in line of duty as such soldier, at Duckamunga, State of Tenn,

Twenty-third day of September, 1863, I was wounded in

(Here state fully and clearly all the facts, showing the injury,

the lower right breast, and right shoulder. the

wound at the time effected the sight of right eye and

I have not been able to see with that eye since. I

was taken to Montgomerie hospital, where I

remained about five weeks. I have never been able

since the wound to earn my living by manual labor.

The wound has since been a continuous source of trouble

to me, frequently causing me to take to my bed

and that as the direct result of said injuries, thus received in line of duty during the war, I am now unable to gain a livelihood by manual labor; that I have continuously since January 1st, 1880, been a citizen of Florida; that neither I, nor my wife, nor both combined, own real and personal property to the value of \$600 in this or any other State, and have not purposely disposed of our property for the purpose of availing ourselves of the provisions of the pension laws of Florida; that I am not otherwise enabled, or in a position to earn, and have no income from any source sufficient for, a livelihood, and that I have no children or other relation able so to do, and whose legal duty it is to support me, and that I never deserted the Confederate service, and that I receive a pension from no other source.
