treated in C.S.A. Gen'l Hosp.
Wilmington, N.C. from Jan'y
16 to Feb'y 24, 1863 for pneumo-
nia, and then granted a
furlough.

Prisoners of war records
show him as J. Pittman private
Co. E, 1 Confederate Batt. Ga.
Inf., formed in part from 29 Ga.
Inf., paroled near Greensboro, N.C.,
May 1, 1865. No rolls of latter
organization on file.
