Dear Mrs. Pedrick:

This will acknowledge your letter of December 9, requesting information to substantiate the facts enumerated in your letter, and that this particular individual did serve in the War between the States.

Our records indicate that Thomas Nathaniel Milton received a pension from the State of Florida for Confederate Military Services under certificate #10168 up to the time of his death, and that his wife drew a Confederate Veteran's Widow's Pension after his decease.

He enlisted at Savannah, Georgia in October, 1861, with rank of Private, and served in Company F 29th Georgia Infantry. The commanding officer at time of enlistment was Captain Rockwell.

He was married to Lucy A. Massey December 20, 1897 in Baker County, Florida, and he died October 28, 1930.
