I know personally of the above stated service, because I served with Wherry Cason in Company B, 1st Florida, Regiment of the State of Florida, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Madison, in the State of Florida, on the day of May 1865, by reason of end of war, and I did not desert the Confederate States service nor take the oath of allegiance to the United States before the close of the war.
