

Widow's Pension Claim

UNDER THE ACT OF 1909

One Thousand Nine Hundred and *nine*, personally appeared before me, a *Clerk et. et.* in and for the County and State aforesaid *Martha Jane Cason* a resident of *Genoa* County of *Hamilton* State of Florida, who being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain a pension under the provisions of Chapter 5885, Laws of Florida, approved June 7, 1909.

That she is the widow of *W. C. Cason* who was enlisted under the name of *W. C. Cason* on the *March* day of *1864*, in Company *"B"* *1st Fla Reserve* Regiment of the State of *Florida* and who was honorably discharged at *Madisonville, Fla*, 1865, on account of *close of war*
