1. What is your name and where do you reside? *James L. White,*

2. How long have you known the applicant? *I do not know her.*

3. Where does she reside and how long has she been a resident of this State? .....

*Do not know.*

4. Were you acquainted with her husband? *Yes*

5. Where and to whom was she married? *Do not know where. I*

*was well acquainted with W. C. Cason.*

6. Is he dead? If so, when and where did he die? *Yes, he died in*

*Hamilton Co., Fla. I have been informed*

7. Was he a soldier or sailor in the State or Confederate service during the war between the States?

*Yes*

8. When did he enlist, and in what organization? *In 1864, in*

*Co. B, 1st Fla. State Reserves.*
